

COACHES RESCHEDULES/ WEATHER POSTPONED GAMES FOR CANCELLATIONS FOR FALL 2008

If your game is canceled / postponed, canceled due to weather, or terminated prior to the half (for reasons other than misconduct), the Competition Coordinator will reschedule your game.

For rescheduled game information use the ENSA web site: www.ensa.us, under: Reschedules, to find your teams reschedules.

This is the only way that rescheduling information will be available.

It is the coach's/club's responsibility to check the ENSA web site for their reschedules. Failure to do so may cause a forfeit and a fine.

STEP BY STEP COACH'S REQUEST RESCHEDULING PROCEDURE

1) If a team is unable to play a game, it is the responsibility of the **REQUESTING COACH** to notify the competition coordinator, via the web site (Contact the Coordinator), email compcoord@ensa.us or call (402) 616-6697. Each team may request **one** game to be rescheduled at no cost to the teams club. Additional coaches reschedule requests will cost \$25 each, and this cost will be charged to the team's club, and will be assessed by the league treasurer at the end of the season. These requests for rescheduling must be made to the competition coordinator at least 10 days prior to the game.

2) **Requesting Coach** should contact the opposing coach, at least 10 days prior to the game, to notify him of the requesting teams inability to play as scheduled, and determine two(2) mutually agreeable, potential reschedule dates.

3) **Requesting Coach** should then contact the competition coordinator, via email, with the reschedule request and potential reschedule information. Make sure to list the teams involved coaches names, available dates and game number. If the Requesting Coach is unable to contact the opposing coach, he **still** must notify the competition coordinator at least 10 days prior to the game.

4) **Competition Coordinator** will review reschedule information and will notify both coaches, via email, of the confirmed reschedule date, time and field. The rescheduled game information will then be placed on the ensa web site.

If any of the potential reschedule dates & times are **NOT** available or workable, then the rescheduling process will start over again.

A team that can not play on the scheduled date, after using the one allowed reschedule or notifying the competition coordinator less than 10 days prior to the game, will **FORFEIT** the game. The fine for forfeiting is \$25.00 for the first game, \$50.00 for the second game, and \$100.00 for the third and additional games. Failure to provide 72 hour notification, or a no-show, will result in a fee of twice the amounts listed plus the normal referee fee for the game.

**STEP BY STEP RESCHEDULING
PROCEDURE DUE TO WEATHER CANCELLATIONS**

- 1) It is the responsibility of **BOTH** coaches to contact each other to reschedule the game as soon as possible after the games cancellation. The coaches need to mutually agree upon two(2) potential dates that will work for both teams.
- 2) **Either Coach** then needs to email the agreed upon potential dates for the rescheduled game to the competition coordinator. Make sure to include the game number, both teams names, both coaches names and potential games(2) dates.
- 3) **Competition Coordinator** will review the request and then notify both coaches via email of the games rescheduled date, time and field. The rescheduled game will then be posted on the ensa web site. If the asked for dates are not available the competition coordinator will email ther coach back to look for new dates.

******* If neither coach contacts the competition coordinator within 7 days from the games weather cancellation, with potential rescheduling dates, the competition coordinator will have the authority to reschedule the game. *******

******* If a team is not able to make the games reschedule date and time they will then lose by forfeit. *******
